# springbig email: about our email designer/editor

our drag-and-drop email editor makes it easy to create email messages within the springbig platform


it combines a great ease of use with many features that give you *full control* on the design of your emails

it is a drag-and-drop interface that enables you to design professional email messages without any knowledge of HTML, and produces code that adapts automatically to small screens, such as that of a smartphone or tablet


from a budtender who has never been involved in email marketing to the most experienced CMO, our new email editor can be used by anyone to create an email campaign within minutes

# springbig email: getting started

to get started using our email editor, you must login to your springbig account and create a new campaign




# springbig email: creating a new campaign

# springbig email: selecting a template



# step 5.

select the preloaded template you would like to use

#### step 6.

next, the springbig email editor will appear and you will be able to create your new email based on the template you selected

#### step 7.

once you are ready to send the campaign, click the 'SAVE' button at the top right of the email editor screen

# springbig email: completing your campaign

after saving your template, you will be redirected back to the campaign screen


#### step 8.

it is *mandatory* that you use this space to write a subject line for your email

a preview of your saved email template will be displayed here

#### step 10.

once you are satisfied and have filled out all the required fields, click 'send campaign' to send out the email to your customers

# springbig email: types of templates

this page will breakdown the different types of templates that are available to you when using the springbig email editor

#### blank template:

- if you want to create your own email from scratch using our drag-and-drop email editor, you can select this template and build your email as you see fit
- wou can also use the blank template to insert your own HTML into a HTML content block

#### standard pre-existing templates:

- springbig has provided 3 templates that are available to all merchants
- these templates can be edited however you see fit. you can remove and/or add elements to the email template you choose for that specific send
- you can find the layouts of the 3 standard templates available at launch on page 11-13

### springbig email: saving templates for future use

this page will explain how to create or modify a template that you want to use for future email campaigns. if you are modifying a pre-existing template or building an email template from scratch via the 'blank template' and you want to save it for a future template to utilize, you can easily do that


#### step 1

once your email is built, but before you send the campaign, *stay within* the email editor

#### step 2

at the top left, click 'Actions' and then click 'Save as template'

please only click this once.
if you click it repeatedly, you will create duplicate copies of the template and will not be able to delete them without contacting your client success manager



# springbig email: important information & tips

this page will detail the *important points to keep in mind* when using springbig's email editor:

- 1. springbig automatically adds your physical mailing address and unsubscribe link to all emails sent out of the springbig platform. (note: this is not optional)
- 2. the *maximum* image size is 12 mb
- 3. we do not offer a preference center for when your customers want to opt out
  - if a customer opts out of your email program they will opt out of all emails sent through the springbig system
- 4. you will not be able to delete any templates
  - if you need to delete a custom template, please reach out to your client success manager
- 5. if you are using your own HTML, you *must ensure* that your HTML coding is already coded for responsive design
  - when using your own HTML we cannot guarantee that the email will render responsively (will render perfectly on any screen size)


## springbig email: important information & tips cont.

6. when using a text block, if you do not put any content into the text block you must delete that text content block, otherwise the email will display the following in your email message:

"I'm a new Text block ready for your content."

- 7. if you need to delete a content block, simply click on it and a trash bin icon will appear
  - click the trash bin icon and that content block will be removed

- 8. if you want to copy/duplicate an already existing content block
  - click on the content block and click on the overlapping square tiles next to the trash bin




# springbig email: important information & tips cont.


9. ever made a mistake and wanted to undo it when building an email? what if you wanted to go back to several edits ago?

the Undo feature allows you to rewind and fast-forward to any point in your recent edit history


- when changes are detected, a compact Undo widget displays in the bottom left corner of the stage
- clicking on the Undo or the Redo arrows allows you to undo the latest edit or re-apply it.




